### About this opportunity:

As a Camp Counsellor at PRES, you will play a vital role in ensuring the safety, well-being, and personal growth of campers during weekend and summer programs. You will foster an inclusive, supportive environment that encourages teamwork, cultural awareness, and confidence, delivering memorable experiences aligned with PRES's mission and values.

Key responsibilities are as follows

- Plan, organize, and lead engaging activities including team-building, arts and crafts, STEM workshops, and outdoor recreation
- Implement structured daily schedules that promote learning, skill development, and fun
- Maintain positive interactions with campers, parents, and fellow counsellors to support collaboration and communication
- Contribute to inclusive programming designed to engage campers from diverse and underrepresented backgrounds
- Supervise all activities to ensure camper safety, well-being, and adherence to camp policies
- Address behavioral challenges constructively and provide emotional support to foster resilience and interpersonal growth
- Apply First Aid/CPR protocols when necessary and support overall health and safety procedures
- Assist with camp operations such as setup, cleanup, and material preparation
- Participate in staff training sessions and support the Camp Director in daily operations
- Deliver day camps (e.g., March Break Camp, Weekend Camp, and Summer Camp) and other virtual and in-person educational programs across the Greater Toronto Area

Requirements:

- Experience working with children or in camp, recreation, or educational settings
- Strong communication, teamwork, and leadership skills
- Ability to supervise groups and manage behavior in dynamic environments
- Ability to work full-time including weekdays and one weekend day depending on scheduling
- Ability to travel across the Greater Toronto Area including Peel Region and Toronto
- Ability to lift and manage materials needed for camp activities
- A valid Standard First Aid with CPR-C certification and a clear Vulnerable Sector Check are required prior to start date (not reimbursed).
- Candidates must be between 15-30 years of age, a Canadian citizen/permanent resident/refugee protection status, and have a valid SIN.

Assets:

- Experience working with diverse or underrepresented youth
- Skills in arts, STEM, sports, or specialty programming
- Multilingual abilities (reading, writing, speaking, listening)
- Access to a vehicle and a valid G2/G Ontario driver's license

This is a fully in-person position. Salary ranges from \$18-26/hour, dependent on experience, skills, education, and role.
