### **About this opportunity:**

As a Photographer at PRES, you will capture high-quality images that highlight camp life, including daily activities, special events, and memorable moments of participants. Your work will support communications, marketing, and program promotion, blending technical photography skills with creativity and an understanding of youth engagement to preserve meaningful experiences in a safe, enjoyable environment.

Key responsibilities are as follows

- Plan and execute photography coverage for candid and posed shots that reflect the vibrancy and spirit of camp
- Edit and retouch photos to meet professional standards for print materials, social media, and promotional campaigns
- Maintain a consistent visual style aligned with the camp's branding and communication goals
- Operate cameras, lenses, lighting, and other photography equipment while troubleshooting technical issues as needed
- Ensure equipment is properly maintained and ready for use throughout the camp season
- Collaborate with camp staff to coordinate coverage, obtain permissions, and support program needs
- Create a comfortable and safe environment for camper photography while upholding privacy and confidentiality standards
- Deliver images promptly for newsletters, social media posts, websites, and internal communication needs

- Oversee post-production tasks including organizing, archiving, and managing photo libraries for future use
- Prepare albums, curated collections, and photo reports for camp management as requested
- Deliver day camps (e.g., March Break Camp, Weekend Camp, and Summer Camp) and other virtual and in-person educational programs across the Greater Toronto Area

Requirements:

- Experience in photography, visual media, or related fields
- Proficiency with cameras, lighting equipment, and photo-editing software
- Strong attention to detail, creativity, and time management skills
- Ability to work collaboratively with staff and engage positively with children and youth
- Ability to work full-time including weekdays and one weekend day depending on scheduling
- Ability to travel across the Greater Toronto Area including Peel Region and Toronto
- A valid Standard First Aid with CPR-C certification and a clear Vulnerable Sector Check are required prior to start date (not reimbursed).
- Candidates must be between 15-30 years of age, a Canadian citizen/permanent resident/refugee protection status, and have a valid SIN.

Assets:

- Experience photographing youth programs, events, camps, or community settings
- Knowledge of Adobe Lightroom, Photoshop, or other editing tools
- Experience working with diverse or underrepresented communities
- Multilingual abilities (reading, writing, speaking, listening)
- Access to a vehicle and a valid G2/G Ontario driver's license

This is a fully in-person position. Salary ranges from \$18-26/hour, dependent on experience, skills, education, and role.
